Tuition and Fees – Elementary Program 2017 – 2018 School Year

New Student Application Fee: \$100 (includes assessment fee)

Annual Registration Fee: \$300 before May 31st; \$350 June 1st and after

Annual Tuition:

	Grade Level	Annual Tuition
Elementary	Transitional Kindergarten – 6 th Grade (8:15am – 3:00pm, Monday – Friday)	\$6,150/year

P.E. Uniform: \$14 per student for 5th – 6th Grades

Music: \$12 Grades 3rd – 4th (Recorder + book; or \$6 for book only)
 \$20 Grade 5 + cost of instrument rental
 \$10 Grade 6 + cost of instrument rental

Payment Plan: Tuition payments may be paid on a monthly basis in 10 payments beginning August 30th – May 31st.

Other Available Discounts:

Family Referral – Refer a new family and when they register in our program, you will receive a \$25/month tuition discount on your account for the current school year. The family you refer must remain enrolled in order for the discount to apply.

Full Tuition Payment – A 5% discount is available if payment of the full tuition amount is received by September 6th.

Multiple Student Discount – Tuition for the oldest child is full price and a 5% discount off the tuition is applied for the second student, 10% for the third, and so forth. To verify correct tuition payments, please contact school’s Accounting Department.

Before and After School Care: \$7 per day per student from 7:00am – 8:00am (drop in rate)
 \$20 per day per student from 3:00pm – 6:00pm (drop in rate)
 \$60 per month per student from 7:00am – 8:00am (monthly rate)
 \$175 per month per student from 3:00pm – 6:00pm (monthly rate)

Optional Additional Fees:

Enrichment Activities – Gymnastics, soccer, tennis, tae kwon do, chess, guitar, ukulele, voice, and Intellibricks classes are available after school for additional costs.

Extracurricular Programs – Participation in extracurricular programs vary depending on activity (cheerleading, track and field, cross country, volleyball, and basketball)

Field Trips – Each class attends two – three field trips during the year. Costs vary depending on activity.
