Dear Sixth-Eighth Grade Parents,

Camp is just around the corner and I don't know about you, but I'm getting more excited each day. Plans are in place for a great four days with the 6-8th grade students. We are blessed again this year to have Scott Anderson, from San Diego, come and teach our kids about "The Armor of God" and how He "Equips us" to do what He calls us to do when we Armor Up. It's going to be a great week of learning and growing for our students.

Here are some logistics about camp that you will need to know.

- All permission slips for students and driver forms must be turned in no later than **Thursday** of this week. (Mr. Wilkins will be sending the drivers form to you today if you signed up to drive. If you don't receive a form please email him asap.)
- Students will arrive at school at **8:30 a.m.**, the morning of Tuesday Sept. 12th. We will load cars, pack our suitcases & sleeping bags, get some instructions, pray together and plan to leave school about 9:30 - 9:45 a.m.
- Students will need to bring a sack lunch with a drink for Tuesday.
- We will stop at Penn Valley Park on our way to camp to have lunch, play and find out what groups we are in.
- The students will be divided into 8 groups for camp. Each group has a staff member as their leader, both boys and girls and all grades. The teams will work together throughout their time at camp in a variety of ways: team building, games, dining hall duty etc.
- A packing list will accompany this email. Sleeping bags, pillows and a small suitcase please. Whatever they bring they have to be able to carry to their cabin from the main road.
- The boys cabins are on the upper road and the girls cabins are on the lower road. Sixth grade girls and boys will have their own designated cabins and junior high girls and boys will have their own designated cabins. Forest Lake Christian School will be joining us for camp this year. They will have their own cabins as well.
- No Food is allowed in the cabins so please don't send snacks
- If you want to send a letter to your child while they are at camp here is the address - Woodleaf Young Life Camp Attn **Your Child's Name** 11359 La Porte Rd, Challenge, CA 95925. We love to have them sing or do something silly for their mail. Mail early so it arrives before we leave.
- Parents working in the kitchen will be doing a lot of meal prep three times a day. It is a lot of work and we absolutely appreciate all those who have volunteered to work the kitchen with the Woodleaf crew.

- If your child will need any medication, including cough drops or Tylenol etc., you will need to fill out a prescription permission form and have the medication to us in the office by Monday Sept. 11 if possible. Tuesday medication with a form already filled out will be accepted if it needs to be refrigerated or it's a daily medication you can't leave at the office the day before.
- We will have a nurse with us at camp but please log into RenWeb this week and make sure all of your information is updated.
- We plan to be arrive back at school by 3:00 p.m. on Friday, Sept. 15th.

We would love to have you praying now for our camp and then of course throughout the week. This is such a great opportunity for students and staff to bond and for the students to grow in their walk with Christ. If you have any questions please don't hesitate to ask.
