4. Bayside Church Welcome/Update – Jud Boies, John Volinsky & Brian Jenkins

- a. Campus security guard is now armed
- b. Meetings with Forest Lake Christian School are continuing to start a high school on our campus. Meetings take place every other week. Projection is for a freshman class in Fall 2019. Discussion of Forest Lake moving their entire campus to Adventure and keep only a satellite campus on their current Auburn campus. Or ours may be developed as a second campus. Occupancy zoning for students on our campus is 1,200 students. We already have 600 K-8 students, so that does not allow for a very large high school.
- c. Bayside already has a contract with South East University (SEU) for Thrive students to get accredited college credits. That could be an additional opportunity for our students to progress through 2 years of college credit.
- d. Bayside Church is launching a capital campaign in March. This fundraising could help push the high school goals forward. Pray for donors in our community that may have a passion for financially supporting Christian education in our community.
- e. The City responded about construction of additional classrooms: They requested additional information about access routes for children to exit building in case of emergency and a response is being prepared. Positive progress overall.
- f. Brian Jenkins update on security: walked through campus with a security consultant. Conclusion of that walk through was to have a professional assessment completed and Roseville Police Department assessment. Progress is being made. Thank you for parent comments and input from last meeting; all are being taken to heart.
- g. Parent question: Who pays for these assessments and security enhancements? Those details are still being determined.
